Weekly Vulnerability Report

23 March 2026

This report summarizes the Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures (CVEs) which have been modified by the National Vulnerabilities Database (NVD) in the past month. This data can help users prioritise and manage the vulnerabilities that might pose a risk to their organisations.

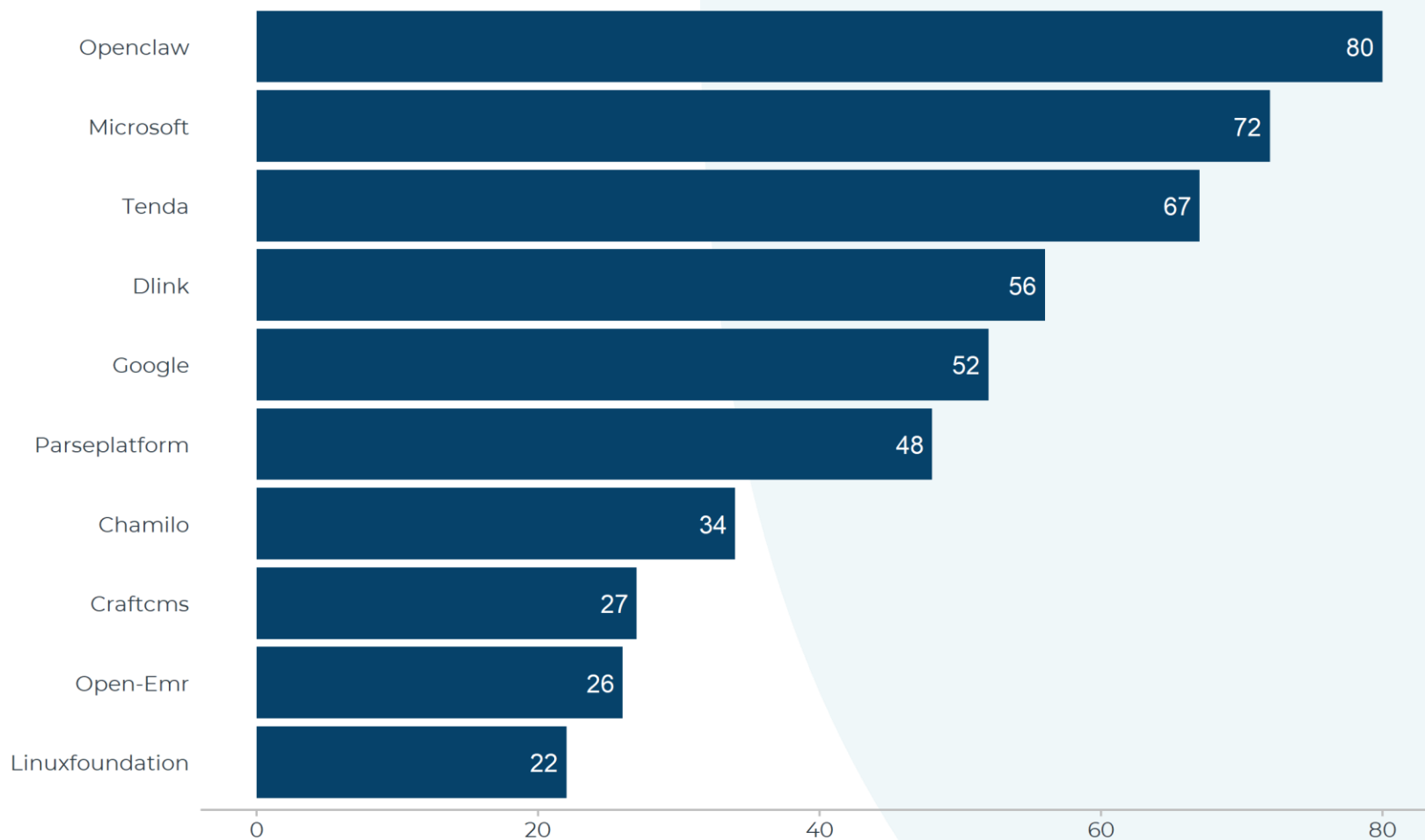
The report includes a breakdown of the number of CVEs by vendor (top ten) and a table which displays the highest priority CVEs. These include:

- CVEs that have been added by CISA to the [Known and Exploited catalogue](#) (CISA KEV), or
- CVEs with a [Common Vulnerability Scoring System](#) (CVSS) score above or equal to 6 and an [Exploit Prediction Scoring System](#) (EPSS) score above or equal to 0.2

Each CVE number in the table has a link to the vendor advisory where users can find mitigation or remediation guidance.

- FIRST - Exploit Prediction Scoring System (EPSS). EPSS is an estimate of the probability of the CVE being exploited in the wild in the next 30 days.
